Description: The Fairbanks Soil & Water Conservation District is holding a “Bucks for Bales” contest this year for farmers who wish to enter their hay bales. A panel of agricultural specialists will judge the bales and take hay samples from the top 3 bales for laboratory analysis. Cash and bragging rights will be awarded to the farmers with the best hay. Bales will be on display in the Lergen Barn for the duration of the Fair.

How to Enter: Drop off your best bale (45-65 lbs.) at FSWCD mid-July. Each producer may only enter one bale in each category. Hay must have been grown in the Tanana Valley during summer 2017.

Judging Criteria:

1. Moisture content
2. Visual appearance-(color, leaf retention, texture, maturity)
3. Impurities-(dust, mold, weeds)
4. Nutrient analysis
